Holy Week Liturgy Registration

Due to limited capacity pandemic regulations, **pre-registration** is required for **Good Friday**, Saturday **Easter Vigil** liturgies and **Easter Sunday Masses**.

Registration is **NOT** required for **Holy Thursday**.

Online registration via our parish website <http://saintdominic.ca> is available now on a first come/first served basis.

There are **three Good Friday services**. The 11 a.m. liturgy is geared to children. *The 3 and 5 p.m. services are identical!* This liturgy is offered twice to allow adequate, socially distanced seating for a larger number of parishioners.

Seating will not be assigned. However, all parishioners will be greeted by our usher/greeters, asked for their registration and then be directed to specific pews by the hospitality crew. When being seated you are asked to kindly move to the centre of the pew, to allow adequate spacing for additional parishioners at pew ends.
