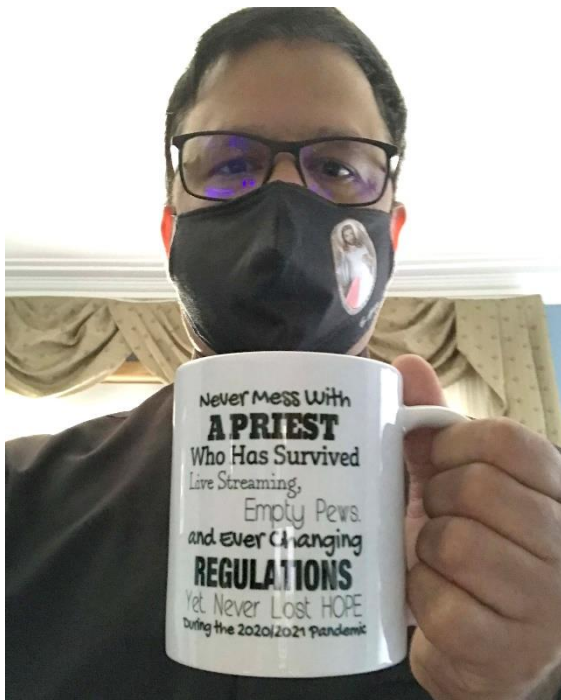




Outdoor Mass Celebrates St. Dominic Reopening

Carmel of Saint Joseph

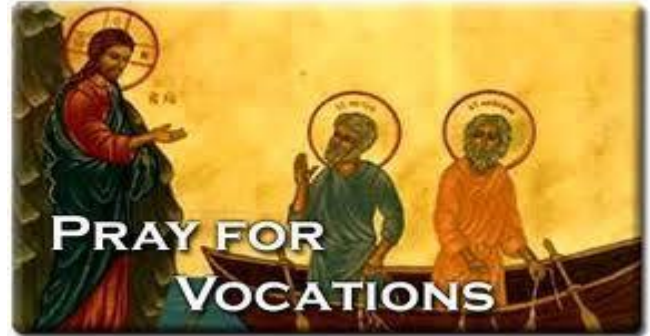
Are you troubled? Do you need spiritual support?
