Feast of Our Lady of Mt Carmel

First officially instituted 1,000 years ago, the solemn liturgical feast of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel** was observed Friday at St. Dominic. Its objective has always been thanksgiving to the Blessed Virgin Mary, patroness of the Carmelite Order, and for the benefits she has accorded those who have recourse to her maternal intercession, are mindful of the primacy of spiritual life and need for prayer.

The scapular consists of two pieces of brown cloth – one segment hanging on the wearer's chest, the other on his/her back. Strings overlapping the shoulders join —hence the word "scapular". Unlike typical sacramentals, scapulars are not merely blessed, but need to be invested by a priest to enroll the faithful – this investiture will be celebrated by our Carmelite pastor, Father Ranjan D'Sa, at all three Sunday Masses this weekend.

60th Anniversary Blessing

Thursday, July 15 – Fr Ranjan confers a special anniversary blessing on JoAnne and Al Oatridge, in celebration of their 60th wedding anniversary. In 1960 JoAnne had been offered the principal's job at St. Phillip's, the newly built school in her hometown of Petrolia. "But I missed my friends, so I came back to teach in London. Very shortly after, I met Allan," she says. Al and Joanne were married at St. Phillips Catholic Church in 1961. "Many of our friends were able to come and we enjoyed a beautiful day," she recalls. And since then – "all has been really good!"

Oakville has been their home since their wedding. Al was an engineer at Ford until he became a university professor for many years. JoAnne taught at St. James and George Vanier Schools.

The Oatridges have been St. Dominic parishioners since 1961. Al was a Lector and served as Organizer of that ministry for about 15 years. JoAnne was involved in the music ministry and used to have her small baby in a carrier beside her at the organ when it was still in the balcony. In 2000, she was a member of the parish committee planning activities to celebrate the Jubilee. Her more recent interests have been in preparing youngsters for Confirmation. "I have done this for a few years but the most recent was done primarily over the phone!" she says. In years past, on Sundays the Oatridges also took Communion to the Seniors' residence on Lakeshore, where they enjoyed seeing them and having a chat!

Liturgical Norms Evolving For Step 3 of St Dominic Reopening

Based on diocesan directives effective July 16, St. Dominic Parish is moving to gradually reintroduce and increase liturgical ministers for Sunday Masses. Our current ministry schedule runs through September 5, so most changes to the number of Lectors or Extraordinary Ministers of Communion will be folded into the next ministry schedule. However, Altar Servers will slowly be reintroduced to Masses in August.

Beginning now, the dialogue with individual communicants as they approach the minister for Communion – "The Body of Christ" / "Amen" – can be resumed.

Following consultation with medical advisers, the reception of Holy Communion on the tongue is now permitted – *with these caveats*: Those wishing to receive Communion on the tongue

- > may do so *only from the Priest*, and
- > must wait until all other persons receiving Communion in the hand, have been served.

Pandemic practices – NOT changed

- One-way movement for entry and exit is retained.
- All who participate in the liturgy must sanitize their hands before entering the church, must wear masks for the duration of the celebration and maintain physical distancing.
- Priests and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion must wear masks for distribution of Communion and continue to sanitize their hands prior to Communion distribution.
- Music leadership is restricted to an instrumentalist and cantor only.
- The collection will continue to be received at the three church doors.
- The dispensation from the Sunday Obligation remains in effect.
- The resumption of printed bulletins and return of hymnals to the pews, and the reintroduction of choirs will not take place at this time. Decisions on these issues will be made as more information is provided by the government and health authorities.


